Gradings...

The initial gradings for the firsts, seconds and thirds were announced on Sunday 28th March.

These gradings are by no means permanent, and at least one selector will be in attendance at all games.

Players will be promoted or relegated to other gradings according to:-

1. Attendance at training.
2. Fitness.
3. Punctuality at games and training.
4. Turnout which includes clean boots and laces.
5. Standard of play each week.

Should any player be unavailable for training or a particular game he must inform the coach or a selector one week in advance. Failure to attend training without notification will result in immediate relegation to a lower grade.

Team changes will be announced at Tuesday's training so that ~~as~~ the new team can train together prior to the next competition game. It is likely that only the selections for fourth grade will be notified via the newsletter.

Should any player have any complaints during the season re gradings, he should see coach Max Mitchell and/or any of your Selectors and voice his opinion. They will give you a fair hearing.
